Your privacy is important to us, and we take it seriously. We provide this Privacy Policy to explain how Rea Landscape Management, LLC ("RLM," "we," "us," or "our") collects, uses, and discloses your information.

What This Policy Covers

This Privacy Policy applies to www.realandscape.com and all related websites and subdomains (our "Website"), related our operations and our services.

This Privacy Policy applies to information we collect online, including information you provide to us and information collected automatically. Our Website may contain links to other websites that we do not operate or control. This Privacy Policy does not apply to the information practices of any third-party whose website may be accessible through our Website, or to any third-party websites on which we advertise.

Information We Collect

Information You Provide To Us

We collect information you provide directly to us, such as when you fill out a form, contact us via email or online, or create an account on our employee portal platform.

We use BambooHR, a third-party employment application tracking system, to assist in managing our recruitment and hiring processes. When you apply for a position with us, the information you provide as part of your application, such as your resume, cover letter, and contact details, may be processed and stored by BambooHR on our behalf. Information We Collect Automatically

You can browse our Website without telling us who you are or revealing your personally identifying information. But like most companies, we automatically collect certain information from all visitors to our Website. How We Use Your Information
